Background History

The General Security Services Ltd was founded with allies with rich background in private security related services. With a great zeal, the founders recognized there was a need and market still growing in Kenya with a large clientele who are not yet satisfied with the services. In reviewing the shortcomings and frustrations in the Industry, an idea was then born to find solutions. Three General since its foundation is still confident have the skills to fill the void of personalized and quality services in the security industry.

The Company Structure

The guard services is projected to rise to 500 guards by the end of the year 2020. In an industry that has about ten major players, we choose to compete with only the best as can be attested to by the high profile assignments we have continued to attract and handle today.

Since establishment to date, we have meticulously managed and controlled the growth of the business and size of its operations in order not to compromise on our stated mission on quality of service to our customers in addition to our deep rooted responsibility to Human capital.

We have met these demands by organizing ourselves in the following manner:

SECURITY GUARDS

We have set ourselves the following basic criteria, which must be met before recruitment of a guard into the Company for training:

Requirements

- Must be a Kenyan Citizen
- Age 23 years and above
- Height 5ft 8 inches and above for men and 5ft 5 inches for ladies
- At least a Certificate of Secondary Education Mean Grade D+ and above
- Certificate of Good Conduct from Criminal Investigation Police Department
- Letter of reference from Government Administrative Area Chief
- Possession of a National Identity Card
- Letters of introduction from two referees giving their contacts together with copies of their National Identity Cards.
- A letter from the last employer if previously employed

Having satisfied the above requirements, the candidates sit for an aptitude test and only those who are admitted to the training school.

TRAINING

The guards undergo three weeks intensive training course in the capable hands of qualified trainers, under the direct supervision of the Managing Director. The training ensures that the recruits are fully conversant with their responsibilities and procedures involved in efficiently carrying out their duties.

Areas of Study During Training

- Company code of conduct
- Drill
- First Aid
- Duties and responsibilities Self Defence
- VHF Radio Communication
- Telephone communication
- Search Techniques
- Patrol
- Social responsibility and the environment
- Weekly assessment tests are done to evaluate the performance of each guard, and those who fail do not continue with the training.

At the end of the Three weeks the recruits sit for an examination. Those who pass are ready to be deployed on new assignments internally or externally with other competing firms; we do not always absorb all our recruits.

Refresher Courses

After six months continuous service the guards are called back for two weeks refresher Training.

1. DEPLOYMENT

The Operations Manager and Deployment Officers place the guards in different assignments after a detailed and complete survey of the premises.

Emphasis is given to the clients' specifications and the prevailing security needs of the premise. Guards deployed to every new assignment must be introduced to the client who is encouraged to participate in a supplementary survey and briefing on security matters pertaining to that particular premise before active duty.

2. UNIFORMS

Three General Security has a standard uniform policy and should the client have specific needs then we provide for the same. The uniforms issue and exchange for normal wear and tear is free of charge to the guard.


3. SUPERVISION

The guards are under supervision from our trained motorbike supervisors two times per shift while Senior Managers carry out spot checks.

Our guards channel their problems if any through the supervisors and the Managers who visit them.

4. PROMOTION

Promotion is purely on merit, and the can move up the ranks as follows;



5. HANDLING OF COMPLAINTS From clients regarding guard/guards are channeled through our customer service manager who in turn ensures that all complaints are handled and receive the attention they deserve.

6. EVALUATIONS

This is carried out by our Investigation officers who monitor and evaluate the conduct of the guards its relation to the service provided to the clients.

7. COMMUNICATION EQUIPMENTS

The Company has invested in Motorola Communications and the models installed are the GM 350 mobile and portable radios. The Head Office Supervisors and Managers are accessible at any given time of the day or night on radio through the control room. The controllers manning the control room for 24 hrs ensure that all operations are running smoothly and any problems arising receive immediate attention.

8. ALARM INSTALLATIONS

Standards

General Alarm Systems conform, to standards set by The Kenya Security Industry Association (KSIA). The Alarms are wired using the closed circuit principle to enable detection of wires that may be cut deliberately or accidentally.

Push Buttons

These are manually operated alarm systems. In case of an emergency the push button is pressed which activates the transmitter to call for back up. There are optional features, which include wireless remote panic button, which can activate the alarm within a radius of 80 meters.

Domestic Automatic Alarm Systems

This system eliminates the need to manually activate the alarm transmitter. It consists of two Magnetic Door Contacts, two Passive Infrared Sensors, a Panel which controls the above and a minimum of three Panic Buttons.

This system detects intrusion and triggers the alarm, which sends the signal to the main control room, and a backup is dispatched.

Commercial Automatic Alarm

This is a more complex system. The type of the alarm to be installed depends on the size of the premises, goods and the areas to be protected. It is advisable to carry out a survey and consultation with the client before installation. It consists of dualtech, infrared detectors, vibration sensors, smoke detectors and Magnetic Door Contracts.

Closed Circuit Television CCTV

This is a system comprising of cameras installed on appropriate area of protection as per client's specification zone. It comprises of cameras, monitors multiplexers, and Video Recording. This enables the clients to monitor all the activities in his absence/presence. CCTV can be computer based as well, which can also enable the client to monitor all the activities from a certain location or through networking.

Electronic Access Control

This is a complete solution for monitoring and control of physical Access. From the simple stand- alone reader for a single door to the most complex access control system. Whether you are a small organization requiring a small-scale solution, or a large organization.

The magnetic card technology used with synel range of products takes advantage of high security encoding to your requirement. An example is the bar code, fingerprint, proximity reader etc. All cards for the product range, including location cards, are made of PVC with a high coercively Magnetic Strip. Three General will invest in a number of vehicles and motorcycles to support its operation. Each vehicle will be equipped with Radio for communication with our 24hrs manned control room. All movements are recorded to ensure that the intended journey is duly authorized.


